We have many ways that you can connect with us for worship during this time!

1. Sunday Worship on Zoom - the link and phone number are sent out each week via our Constant Contact email. You can also call the office to receive the phone number and link.
 - a. Join via the online link on your computer, laptop, tablet, or smart phone.
 - b. Call in to the service to listen with ANY kind of phone (it does not have to be a smart phone!)

May 23 is a goal date for in-person worship whether it's drive-in or inside depending on the benchmarks listed below.

Oakland and Macomb county data from the state website - two weeks below 10 new daily cases per 100K people and falling, lower than 3% test positivity rate, falling case rate, falling infection rate, vaccination rates continuing to rise.
