A Holy Pilgrimage

Shalom from the Holy Land. To say my pilgrimage to the Holy Land of Israel was sacred is an understatement. This pilgrimage was more than I ever could have dreamed. As we journeyed the streets of Old Jerusalem and through the roads of Bethlehem, it was absolutely unreal to be walking the places that Jesus walked. We read the stories in the Bible and we have heard them most of our lives, but putting your feet to the actual streets dramatically transforms one's understanding of these old stories.

With our group of pastors we took our time traveling the sacred sites. Although, our tour guide, a local from Bethlehem, told us that we could spend everyday of a full year visiting all the sacred sites and still not see it all. To which, I would completely agree. There is so much to see and feel and experience in the Holy Land, that we can only brush the surface with a pilgrimage. Every chance to see it and experience it is well worth it.



We visited the Basilica of the Annunciation (where Mary was told she would give birth to Jesus the Messiah); we walked in the Garden of Gethsemane (where Jesus prayed to God, the night he was betrayed and arrested before the crucifixion.), we walked the Via Dolorosa (where Jesus carried the cross to Golgotha, where he was crucified). These places are beautiful and hauntingly powerful.

I was so blessed to have this opportunity and I hope to provide the opportunity for others interested in the future! I felt safe and welcomed the entire time. The people were more welcoming than anyone I have ever met. It was a beautiful time to journey these sacred places alongside local people. Please watch for more pictures and stories throughout Lent, when we will journey these biblical stories together, with pictures and stories from my own journey where Jesus walked and ministered. Also, please prayerfully consider if this is a pilgrimage you would like to take in the future. I will plan a trip for sometime in 2019 or 2020 to offer these sacred experiences for anyone who is interested.

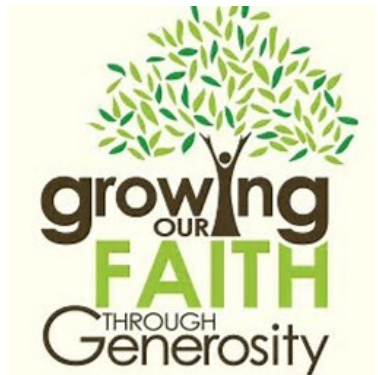

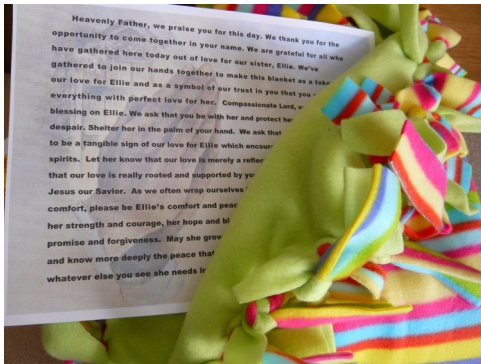

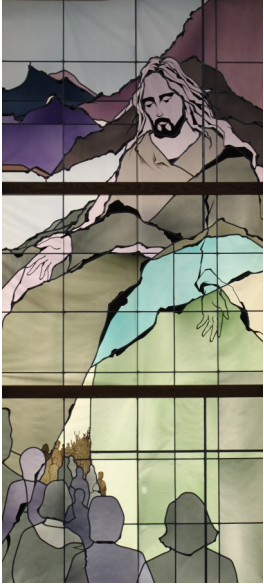
