Next up is a Fun Family Fellowship Bike Ride at Stoney Creek Metro Park. This will be happening on June 11th. Following the 11:00 service there will be a congregational meeting, approximately 30 minutes. Then we will head on out to Stoney for a casual ride. Feel free to pack a picnic lunch for you and yours and we will make plans to break bread together at the park. Stoney Creek is about 15 miles and about a 30 minute drive from the church. Entry fee to get into the park is \$10 per vehicle so let's carpool from the church to save costs. Bike rental is also available at the park for \$7 per hour at Eastwood Beach. That's where we will be meeting up to start riding. Riders are encouraged to wear helmets but it is not required. So don't delay, call today.

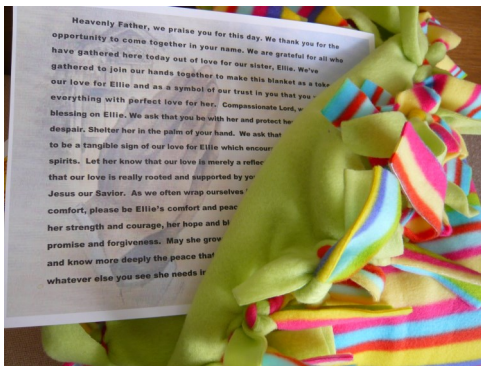

Men of Grace Chili Cook Of Update

On May 7th approximately 80 people attended the 8th Annual Men of Grace Chili Cook Off. Eleven different chilies were entered. The Best Tasting award went to Kevin Liske and Most Unique was won by Dan Lambrix. There were also several awesome desserts and fresh fruit provided by other Amazing Grace members to supplement all the great chili. Mike Martinson was the winner of the Detroit Tigers themed raffle basket. Between raffle ticket sales and free will offerings, \$316 was raised to offset the cost of the event and help pay for the transportation to the annual Men of Grace Detroit Tigers game on August 19th.



The annual Men of Grace Detroit Tigers game will be on Saturday, August 19th, against the Los Angeles Dodgers. This year the game has a unique starting time of 4:05 PM. There are 60 seats reserved in the Mezzanine, Section 218, and we have also contracted luxury coach transportation from Trinity Transportation again. The cost is expected to be \$36 per person or less, depending on whether we can organize any additional fund raising activities to help offset the cost of the transportation.
