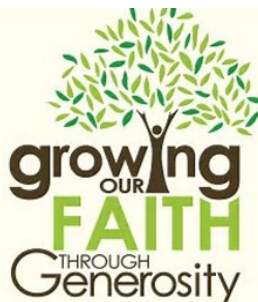

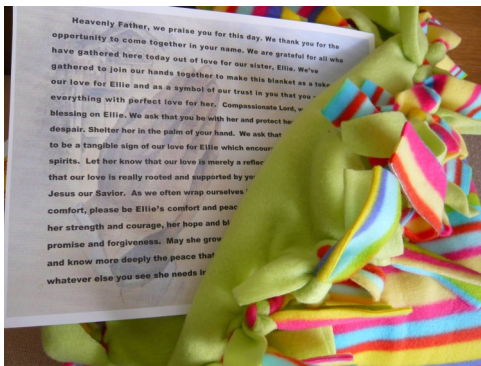


Power of Prayer
