Reformation Sunday Oktoberfest 3:00 - 7:00 P.M.





Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

There are many generous hearts in this congregation and I am amazed at the ways people give of their time, talent and treasure. Hearing people talk about how great online giving is, as well as the joy we see in each other's faces when we celebrate placing offering in the plate each Sunday, emphasizes the joy in which we get to be generous.



As your pastor, I am continually learning how to be generous with my time, talent and treasure and it is certainly an ongoing learning process. As you know, I have faced some challenges these past few months in my life and have had to take a serious look at my faith and finances, just like anyone else. I believe in generosity and am constantly working toward practicing and modeling generosity. I am a dedicated member of Amazing Grace and I want nothing more than this congregation to thrive and accomplish the many great things God has called us toward. I deeply desire that Amazing Grace continues to be a thriving, more vital community and will support God's mission in and around our location.

We are a small but mighty force that depends on many people participating in creative ways. The potential for doing ministry is always huge. 
In keeping with our theme of outdoor activities and adventures for all, October 15 we will be heading out to Yates Cider Mill for some food and excitement. You can enjoy some of their famous apple cider, fudge and doughnuts (I know they are not totally healthy but very comforting!). The kids will also enjoy feeding the **Farm Animals** and



Keep an eye and an ear open for the railroad crossing lights and bells...most kids love to watch the **Pulp Car** haul it's load to the dumping area to see up to 160 bushels of pressed apple pumice fall into the dumpster. You'll want to visit the Apple Tent where you can find a few products that aren't available inside the Mill. Every week, they buy fresh apples from a local orchard grower so you can bag your own apples and pick the size, shape, colors, and varieties you like the best! Pre-bagged apples are also available for your convenience.

After seeing the mill and the apple press we can take a stroll down their river walk trail. It's about ½ a mile so just about anyone can enjoy it. For the more adventurous, bring your bike and your helmet and we'll take a ride on the Paint Creek Trail that starts just a short distance from the mill on the other side of the Clinton River and continues all the way to Lake Orion (about 12 miles), although we probably won't go that far.

As usual we will meet at the church at about 12:30 P.M. if anyone wants to carpool. See Pete for more information. Be healthy and blessed.

I - is for this **INSIGHT**, that his HOLY SPIRIT does proclaim.


